CONTRAINDICATIONS CORVITE®FE should not be used by patients with a known by persensitivity to any of the listed ingredients. All iron compounds are contraindicated in patients with hemochromatosis, hemosiderosis, or hemolytic anemias.

WARNING: Accidental overdose of iron-containing products is a leading cause of fatal poisoning in children under 6. KEEPTHIS PRODUCT OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. In case of accidental overdose, call a doctor or poison control center immediately.

PRECAUTIONS General: Do not exceed recommended dose. The type of anemia and the underlying cause or causes should be determined before storting therapy with CDRYITE® FE. Since the anemia may be a result of a systemic disturbance, such as recurrent blood loss, the underlying cause or causes should be corrected, if possible.

Folic Acid: Folic acid alone is an improper therapy in the treatment of pernidous anemia and other megaloblastic anemias where vitamin B₁₂ is deficient. Folic add in doses above 0.1 mg daily may obscure pernicious anomia in that homatologi remission can occur while nourologic manifestations remai pragressive. Allergic sensilization has been reported following both oral and parenteral administration of folic acid.

The patient's medical conditions and consumption of other drugs, herbs, and/or supplements should be considered.

The clinical course of acute iron overdosage can be variable. Initial symptoms may include abdominal pain, nausea, ventiling diarrhea, tarry stools, melena, hematemesis, hypotension, tachyaardia, metabolic acidasis, hyperglycemia, dehydration, drawsiness, pallor, granesis, lassitude, seizures, shock and coma.
