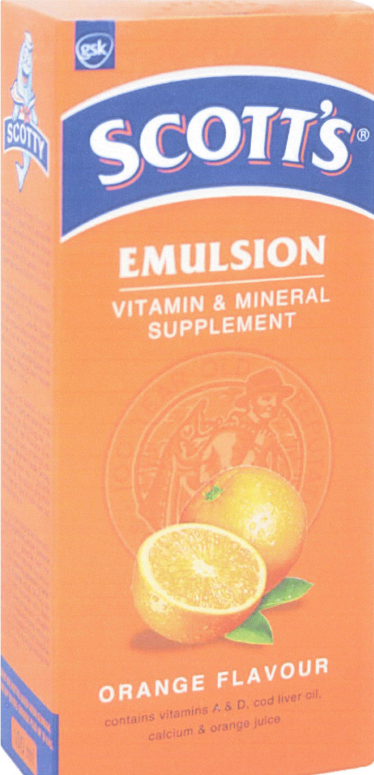

Dosage	Adults and Children >12 years: One tablespoonful (15 mL) 3 times a day. Children 7-12 years: One tablespoonful (15 mL) twice a day; 1-6 years: One tablespoonful (15 mL) once a day. Administration: Shake well before use.
