

Suggested Use: Take one to two capsules no more than 15 minutes before the consumption of histamine-rich foods, or take as directed by your healthcare practitioner.

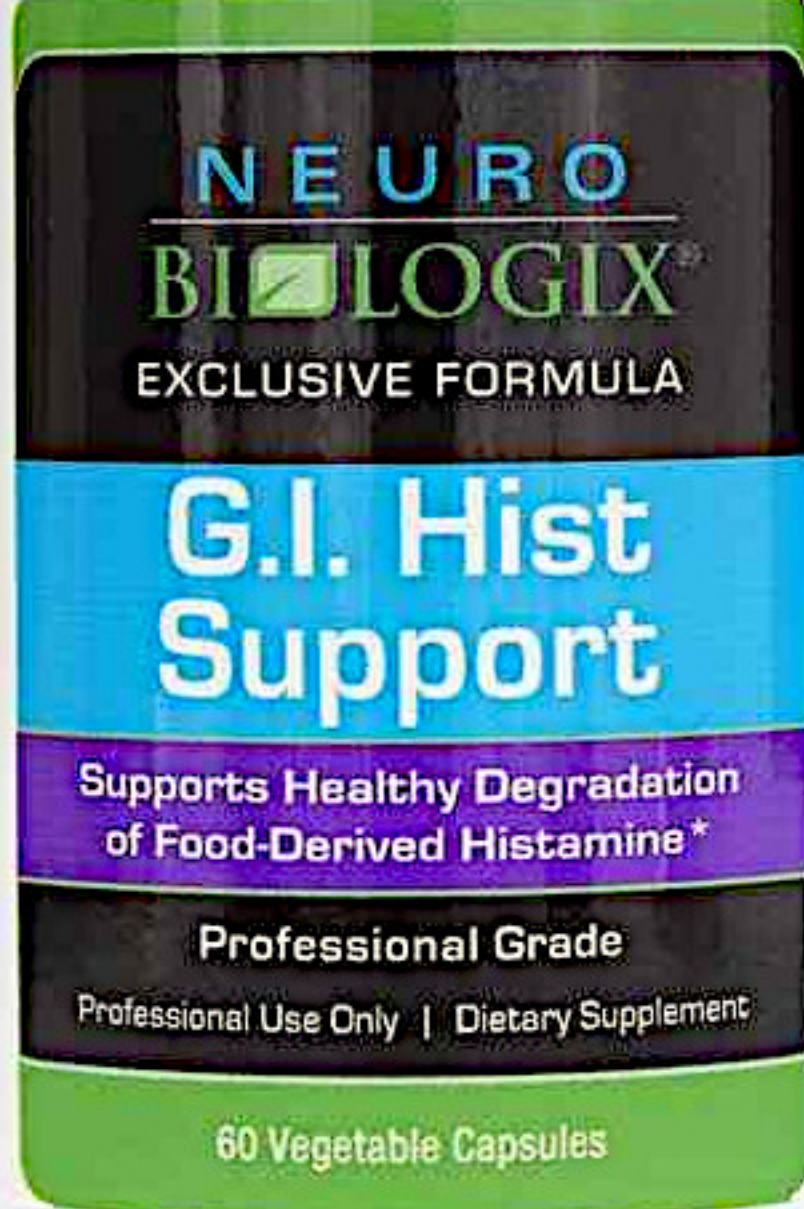
