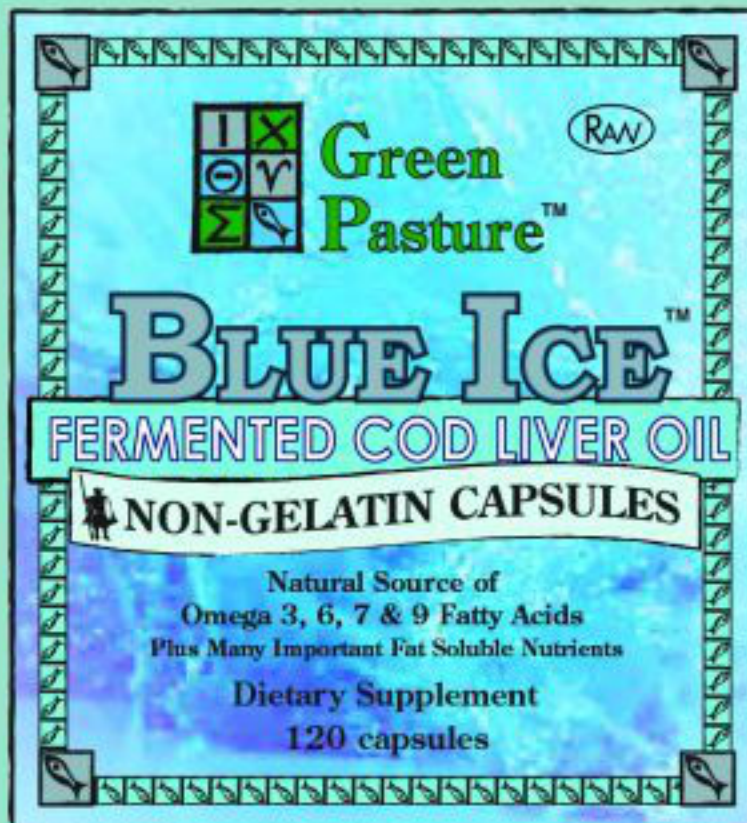

Synthetic chemicals and temperature-controlled mechanization create an industrialized, "cookie-cutter" product that may look appealing, but is devoid of critical nutrients.

Because our hand-crafted cod liver oils are naturally-fermented each batch may vary in appearance and flavor - but retain their all-important nutrient integrity.

Many believe these unique color and taste variations are actually beneficial to their health and respect our decision to adhere to these time-honored traditions.

Each batch of fermented skate liver oil undergoes independent testing for metals, contaminants and a variety of nutrients. Some of the nutrients that we test from time to time for educational purposes include: Quinones (quinones are substances such as vitamin E's, Vitamin K's, CoQ Enzymes etc.), different metabolites of vitamin A and D, EPA, DHA, minerals etc.

Our encapsulated products use only the best available technology for the most non-evasive encapsulation process. The capsules are made of plant cellulose rather than gelatin. Gelatin is made using high temperature, chemicals and requires high heat during the encapsulation process which can compromise the nutrients of the product being encapsulated.

The two-part plant cellulose capsule we use is a unique offering as there are few facilities worldwide having access to this technology to encapsulate liquids.
