Liver Marlin

The liver is the heaviest and one of the largest organ in the body. Located in the upper right part of your belly under the ribs, It is responsible for functions, vital to life. The main functions of the liver are to process nutrients from food, make bile, remove toxins from the body and build proteins. It's easy to see how inflammation of the liver, or hepatitis, interferes with these important functions and can lead to poor health.

Liver Functions

- Detoxification (filters harmful substances from the blood, such as alcohol)
- Stores vitamins A, D, K and B12 (also stores minerals)
- Protein synthesis (makes certain amino acids – the building blocks of proteins)
- The production of biochemicals needed for digestion, such as bile
- Maintains proper levels of glucose in the blood
- Produces 80% of your body's cholesterol (cholesterol is vital)
- The storage glycogen (also converts glucose to glycogen)
- Decomposing red blood cells
- Synthesizing plasma protein
- The production of hormones
- Produces urea (the main substance of urine)

Hepatitis

-Inflammation of the liver and characterized by the presence of inflammatory cells in the tissue of the organ.

Cause of Hepatitis

- Infectious (infected food / water; sexually transmitted disease; unsterilized needles)
- Alcohol, medicines, and chemical may be bad for the liver and cause inflammation.
- Genetic problem, a metabolic disorder, or an immune related injury.
- Obesity can be a cause of liver damage which can lead to inflammation.

Cirrhosis

-Chronic liver disease characterized by replacement of liver tissue by fibrosis, scar tissue and regenerative nodules, leading to loss of liver function.

Ingredients

Milk Thistle

- Milk thistle is a plant native to Europe. It has a long history of use as a folk remedy for liver and gallbladder disorders. The active constituent of milk thistle is silymarin, a flavonoid found in the seeds.
- Flavonoids are most commonly known for their antioxidant activity. The antioxidant abilities of flavonoids are stronger than those of vitamin C and E.
- The seeds of the milk thistle have been used for 2000 years to treat chronic liver disease and protect the liver against toxins.

Protection from Liver Damage

- Milk thistle protects the liver against toxicity from alcohol and other drugs.
- In Europe, milk thistle is reportedly administered to patients when they are given medications known to cause liver problems.

Sodium Ascorbate

- Completely rebuilds the structural integrity of your body via collagen renewal.
- Ascorbic Acid has mistakenly been called Vitamin C – it is actually a liver metabolite rather than a vitamin.
- Important for the health of bones, connective tissues and blood vessels.
- It helps the body to absorb iron needed for the production of red blood cells.
