The female strobiles (fruit) of Hops, or Hop (*Humulus lupulus L.*), used in brewing beer and in traditional medicine, provide lupulin, which contains a bitter acid complex (2-Methyl-3-butenol, humulone, lumulone, lupulone and valeric acid) and a volatile oil complex (humulene, myrcene, B-carophyllene and farnescene.) This extract is standardized at 5.2% alpha bitter acid and 4% flavonoids.

Suggested Usage: As a dietary supplement, adults take 1 capsule daily between meals, or as advised by your health care professional. If digestive irritation occurs, take with meals. Stop use and consult your healthcare professional if allergic reactions occur. Caution: Do not use if you have depressive illness. If you are pregnant or nursing, consult your healthcare professional before using.
